MONDAYS - Health & Protection

- Pray divine health over each person on your prayer list, that every part of their body will function as it was designed to and they will live a long and healthy life. Command sickness to leave and for full health and strength to return to their body. Isaiah 53:5, Psalm 107:19-20.
- Pray that every person will maintain a healthy work/life balance, get proper rest and work from a place of strength and refreshment. Matthew 11:28.

TUESDAYS - Provision
